Regular Meeting - Synopsis

CALL TO ORDER

Due to a lack of quorum, the Regular Meeting of the City of Ionia Planning Commission for April 14, 2010 could not be called to order.

Those in attendance included Commissioners Cook, Hoppough and Paton.

City Manager Jason Eppler was also in attendance.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Vice-Chairperson Paton stated that despite a quorum not being present, comments could be received regarding the proposed Zoning Ordinance amendments.

Vice-Chairperson Paton called for public comments on the proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance establishing standards for Home Occupations in the R-1, R-2, R-3, RT, RM, RM-1 and Planned Unit Development Zoning Districts.

The City Manager explained that notice of the Public Hearing on this proposed amendment was published in the March 21, 2010 edition of the *Sentinel-Standard Weekender*. No comments were received regarding this proposed amendment.
