CITY OF IONIA DIAL-A-RIDE PROPOSED STATE AND FEDERAL APPLICATION FOR OPERATING AND CAPITAL ASSISTANCE

All citizens are advised that the City of Ionia Dial-A-Ride has prepared an application for State of Michigan financial assistance for fiscal year 2020, as required under Act 51 of the Public Acts of 1951, as amended, and for federal assistance as required under the Federal Transit Act as amended.

City of Ionia Dial-A-Ride is requesting \$207,056 in State Formula Operating Assistance for general public transit services; \$88,794 for Federal Section 5311 Nonurbanized Area Formula Operating Program; \$4,500 of Rural Transit Assistance Program; \$21,507 for State Specialized Services transportation funding for elderly persons and persons with disabilities; \$168,500 for Federal Section 5316 Job Access Reverse Commute for continuation funding; and \$302,000 for Federal Section 5339 Capital Discretionary Program funds for three replacement buses, an administrative vehicle, and bus shelter/facility structure updates and \$27,500 for Federal Section 5310 Capital Discretionary Program funds for technology/security upgrades and maintenance equipment.
