- We cordially encourage membership for all Combat Veterans!

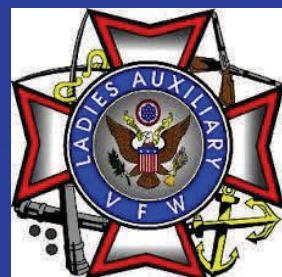

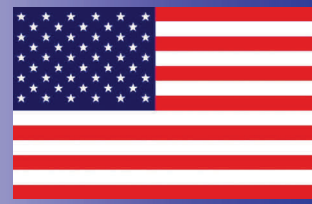
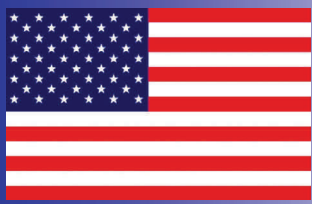
