Divisions: 2 divisions: Age 4 -/1st grade and 2nd/3rd grade. Age as of 9-8-21 or Grade entering in the Fall. 6 teams per division, 10 kids per team. Limit to 60 kids per division. Sign up now!

Where/When: Games and practices will be played at the Harwood Sports Complex. They are played in the outfield of the softball fields. Games will be played on Wednesday nights. **First Game Night will be 9-8-21.** (6 Games) Game times will be 5:30, 6:30 & 7:30 will depend on number of teams. Practice times will be determined by the coach. **The practices start the week of 8-23-21.**

Equipment: Participants are responsible for their own mouth guards and cleats (optional). No metal spikes. Mouth guards are required to be worn. The Parks and Recreation will supply the rest of the equipment. Each player will receive a t-shirt and flags to keep.

Parents: There will be **packets of information that you will need to pick up** with rosters, practice times and game schedules at the Parks and Recreation office starting **August 16th and before August 20th.** First practices will be the week of August 23rd. Coaches: Coaches are needed, please let us know when you register if you are interested in coaching your son or daughter's team. We will run a background check on volunteer coaches. We will go over rosters, rules, games, practices and questions.
